A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NOTICE AND MTI BYLAWS

The Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 2. Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw 753, 2010 is hereby amended by:
- 2.1. Deleting sections 3 and 4 and replacing them with the following:
 - 3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 2 of Schedules 2 to 23, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, may be used to designate an offence against the section of the bylaw appearing opposite thereto in Column 1.
 - 4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules 2 to 23, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, are the penalties established for municipal ticket information relating to an offence against the section of the bylaw appearing opposite thereto in Column 1.
 - i) The amounts appearing in Column 4 of Schedules 2 to 23, attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, are the penalties established for municipal ticket information relating to an offence against the section of the bylaw appearing opposite thereto in Column 1, if paid within 30 days of the date of issuance of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 263 of the Community Charter.
- 2.2. Deleting Schedule 1 (Designated Bylaws and Designated Bylaw Enforcement Officers) and replacing it with Schedule B attached hereto.
- 2.3. Deleting Schedule 5 entitled Highways and Traffic Regulation Bylaw 98-186 and replacing it with Schedule C attached hereto.
- 2.4. Deleting Schedule 14 entitled Encroachment Bylaw 624, 2007, in its entirety.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "BNE and MTI Amendment (Highways) Bylaw 1192, 2022."
