BYLAW 759, 2010

A BYLAW TO AMEND BURNING BYLAW 612, 2007

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country deems it necessary to amend Burning Bylaw 612, 2007;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Burning Bylaw 612, 2007 is hereby amended by:
 - a) Adding a new section 2 (a) as follows:

“Campfires and open burning are not permitted in the District except in accordance with this Bylaw”, and renumbering the remaining sub sections.
 - b) Deleting section 4 (a) in its entirety and substituting:

“All persons conducting “Open Burning” under the provisions of the Bylaw must submit an application for a Burning Permit in the form provided by the District of Lake Country”.
 - c) Deleting section 4 (c) in its entirety and substituting:

“No person shall conduct open burning unless in accordance with an approved burning permit, and during a permitted burning period”.
 - d) Deleting section 6 (a) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

“Application may be made to the Fire Chief or his designate for a special burning permit for air curtain burning for the purpose of disposing of the fuels created from fuel modification or hazard reduction, subject to the conditions that:

 - i) the burn produces no visible smoke once fully operative;
 - ii) no prohibited materials are burned;
 - iii) only wood waste is burned.”

This bylaw may be cited as the “Burning Bylaw Amendment Bylaw 759, 2010”.

READ A FIRST TIME this 6th day of July, 2010.

READ A SECOND TIME this 6th day of July, 2010.

READ A THIRD TIME this 6th day of July, 2010.
