BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER APPOINTMENT BYLAW

BYLAW 764, 2010

A Bylaw to authorize the appointment of officers and employees to enforce
Municipal Bylaws.

WHEREAS pursuant to *The Community Charter* the Council of the District of Lake Country may, by bylaw, establish officer positions and assign powers, duties and functions to those positions,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The position of Bylaw Enforcement Officer is hereby established.
2. Bylaw Enforcement Officers are authorized to enforce municipal bylaws in accordance with the *Community Charter* and the *Local Government Notice Enforcement Act*.
3. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to appoint or terminate the appointment of individuals to the position of Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Bylaw Enforcement Officer Appointment Bylaw 764, 2010."
