Resolution 99.11.619

- When District of Lake Country vehicles are parked or in the field during construction or maintenance activities, emergency flashers must be used to alert oncoming traffic of the stationary vehicle. Alternately, traffic cones must be set out.
- A minimum of two traffic safety cones are to be carried in each District vehicle. A traffic cone or cones is to be placed at the front and/or rear of the vehicle at the operator's discretion as each situation warrants.
- This Policy would also apply to non-District vehicles when used by District employees on District business.
- This Policy would not apply to the above noted vehicles when parked in parking lots.
