A BYLAW TO MAIL BALLOT VOTING BYLAW

---

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Mail Ballot Voting Bylaw 691, 2008 is hereby amended as follows:
  - 1.1. Item 2. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“2. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

    - a) A person wishing to vote by mail ballot shall apply in writing by giving their name and address and providing appropriate identification to the Chief Election Officer or designate, during the period of time established by the Chief Election Officer.
    - b) Upon receipt of a request for a mail ballot where the applicant meets the criteria set out in item 1. b), the Chief Election Officer or designate shall, up until two days before general voting day, make a mail ballot package available to the applicant.”
2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Mail Ballot Amendment Bylaw 997, 2017.”

READ A THIRD TIME this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2017.
