BYLAW 98-185

A BYLAW TO EXCHANGE A PORTION OF BOTTOM WOOD LAKE ROAD AND EXCHANGE LANDS WITH SCHOOL DISTRICT #23 FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES

WHEREAS section 535 of the Municipal Act provides that a Municipality may, by bylaw, dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country deems it necessary and expedient to dispose of that portion of highway shown as Parcel 1, in exchange for certain lands owned by School District #23 shown as Parcel 2, on a plan to be prepared by a BC Land Surveyor of Lot B, Plan 1630, and Lot A Plan KAP48997, both of District Lot 118, Osoyoos Division Yale District, and that such disposition and exchange are necessary and expedient for the purpose of improving and widening a highway.

AND WHEREAS before adopting this bylaw, the Council has caused public notice to be given by advertisement once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper published and circulating in the District of Lake Country.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Authority is hereby given to the District of Lake Country to dispose of Parcel 1, shown cross-hatched on Schedule 'A' attached hereto, in exchange for Parcel 2, shown hatched on Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such documents and take such steps as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this bylaw.
- 3. This bylaw may be cited as "District of Lake Country Road Closure and Exchange Bylaw 98-185".

READ A FIRST TIME this *1st* day of *June*, 1998. READ A SECOND TIME this *1st* day of *June*, 1998. READ A THIRD TIME this *1st* day of *June*, 1998.
