

DISTRICT OF LAKE COUNTRY

BYLAW 638

A bylaw to authorize the temporary borrowing of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000) pending the sale of debentures

WHEREAS Council may, where it has adopted a loan authorization bylaw, without further assents or approvals, borrow temporarily from any persons under the conditions therein set out.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country adopted Loan Authorization Bylaw (Eldorado Reservoir) 608, 2006, authorizing the borrowing of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000);

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Lake Country in open meeting assembled, enact as follows:

1. The District of Lake Country is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow upon the credit of the District of Lake Country, a sum not exceeding One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000).
2. The form of obligation to be given as acknowledgement of the liability shall be promissory notes bearing the corporate seal and signed by the Mayor and the Financial Officer under Section 149 of the Community Charter.
3. The money so borrowed shall be used solely for the purposes set out in said Bylaw 608.
4. The proceeds from the sale of the debentures or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be used to repay the money so borrowed.
5. This bylaw shall be cited as, "Temporary Borrowing Bylaw (Eldorado Reservoir) 638, 2007".
