BYLAW 793

A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW 561, 2007

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country deems it appropriate to amend the District of Lake Country Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007 is hereby amended by:
 - a) Deleting section 12.1.3(d) in its entirety and renumbering the following sections accordingly;
 - b) Deleting section 12.1.5(e) in its entirety and renumbering the following sections accordingly;
 - c) Deleting from section 12.1.7(b)(i) the words “and agri-tourism accommodation”;
- 2) This bylaw may be cited as “Zoning Amendment (Agri-tourism Accommodation) Bylaw 793, 2011”.

READ A FIRST TIME this 7th day of June, 2011.

READ A SECOND TIME this 7th day of June, 2011.

ADVERTISED on the 24th and 30th days of June, 2011 and a Public Hearing waived pursuant to the provisions of Section 890 of the *Local Government Act*.

READ A THIRD TIME this 5th day of July, 2011.
