BYLAW 898

A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW 561, 2007

The Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) Deleting section 19.3.4.(d)(i) of Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007 in its entirety and replacing with the following:
 - (i) Maximum Lot Coverage is 40% and together with driveways and parking areas, shall not exceed 50%.

- 2) Deleting section 19.4.5.(e) of Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007 in its entirety and replacing with the following:
 - (e) Maximum Lot Coverage
Maximum Lot Coverage is 40% and together with driveways and parking areas, shall not exceed 50%.

- 3) This bylaw may be cited as "Zoning Amendment (DLC) Bylaw 898, 2014".
