BYLAW 969

A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW 561, 2007

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007 is hereby amended by inserting the following definition in alphabetical order:

UNPAVED AIRSTRIP AND HELIPAD: means an unpaved runway or helipad intended for the landing and taking off of non-scheduled farm related aircraft that lacks the usual facilities associated with an airport. This use is only permitted in order to supplement an active agricultural operation and may not be used for model flying clubs, for the flying of model aircraft, or for helicopter tours.

2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Zoning Amendment (DLC) Bylaw 969, 2016."

READ A FIRST TIME AS AMENDED this 16th day of August, 2016.

READ A SECOND TIME AS AMENDED this 16th day of August, 2016.

ADVERTISED on the 5th and 12th days of October, 2016 and a Public Hearing held pursuant to the provisions of Section 464 of the *Local Government Act* on the 18th day of October, 2016.

READ A THIRD TIME this 15th day of November, 2016.
