BYLAW 883

A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW 561, 2007

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Lake Country deems it appropriate to amend District of Lake Country Zoning Bylaw 561, 2007.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lake Country, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) Delete the definition of **DRIVE-IN FOOD SERVICES** from Section 3.3.
- 2) Add the following definition to Section 3.3 in alphabetical order:

DRIVE-IN FOOD SERVICES or **DRIVE-IN RESTAURANTS** means development used for eating and drinking which offers food produced in a manner that allows rapid customer service and includes one or more of car attendant services, drive through food pick-up services, or parking primarily intended for the on-site consumption of food within a motor vehicle.

- 3) Add (Lot C Plan 12891) to Section 16.1.2.(l) drive-in restaurants
- 4) This bylaw may be cited as “Zoning Amendment (Harvest Centre Drive-Thru) Bylaw 883, 2014”.

READ A FIRST TIME this 4th day of February, 2014.

READ A SECOND TIME this 15th day of April, 2014.

ADVERTISED on the 30th day of April and the 7th day of May, 2014 and a Public Hearing held pursuant to the provisions of Section 890 of the *Local Government Act* on the 13th day of May, 2014.
